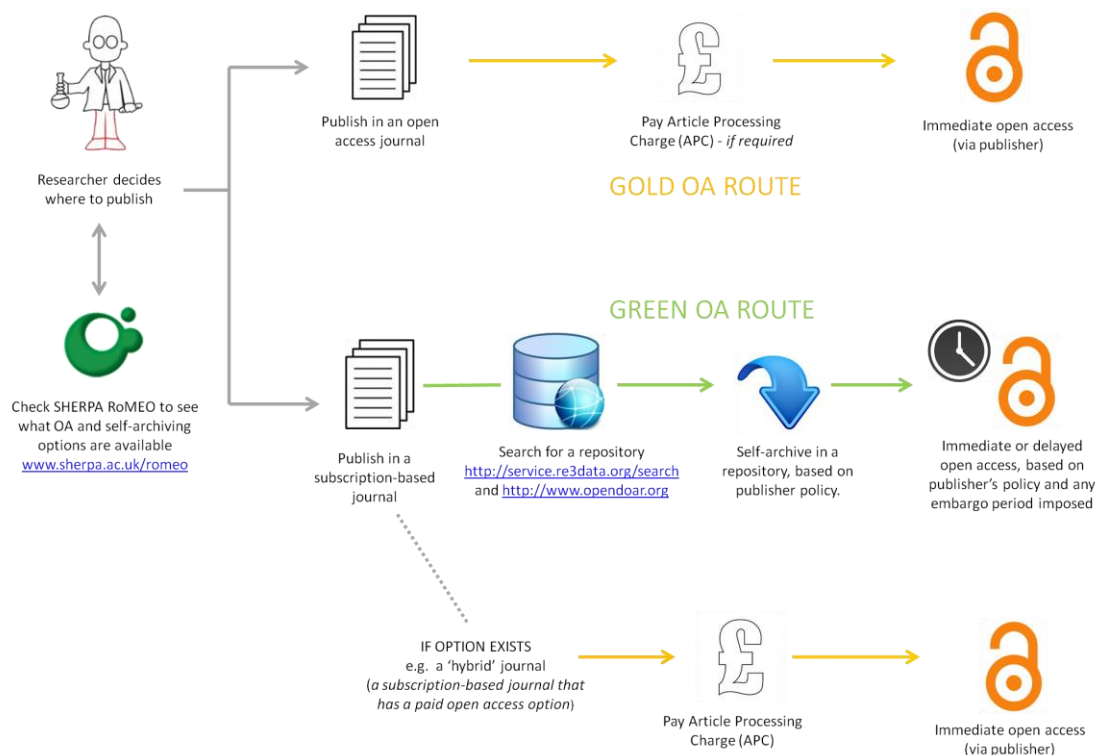

Open access to peer reviewed publications is an underlying principle in the Horizon 2020 and is explained in the Regulation/Rules of Participation as well as in the grant agreement. A novelty in Horizon 2020 is the Open Research Data Pilot which aims to improve and maximise access to and re-use of research data generated by projects.

OpenAIRE (<https://www.openaire.eu/>) implements the Horizon 2020 Open access mandate for publications. It is also one of the key infrastructures supporting the Open Research Data Pilot through European-wide outreach for best research data management practices and Zenodo (<http://www.zenodo.org/>), which provides long-tail data storage. It assists in monitoring Horizon 2020 research outputs and is a key infrastructure for reporting Horizon 2020's scientific publications.
